ROLE OVERVIEW

The French Language Assistant supports the French teachers to provide authentic language and cultural experiences for students as well as prepare them for VCE examinations.

The French Language Assistant engages students in face- to -face language learning. This includes, but is not limited to, team teaching with the French teachers, providing small group or individual student language support and offering grammatical advice on linguistic matters.

The French Language Assistant can also be asked by the teachers to produce or participate in grammatical and cultural resource development, student language immersion experiences and school activities relating to the language and culture.

LINE OF AUTHORITY

Language Assistants will report directly to the Head of Learning Area-Languages and the Director of Campus. Ultimately, all staff are responsible to the Principal.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Support French language students from Year 9 to 12 with authentic language experience
- Engage in face-to-face language learning with small groups or individual students
- Provide advice to students in grammatical, linguistic and communication matters
- Assist students in preparing for VCAA examinations (Year 11 Outcomes/Year 12 SACs and examination)
- Collaborate with teachers in preparing or developing resources
- Report to teachers on students' progress

SELECTION CRITERIA

Essential

- native French speaker
- demonstrated knowledge and understanding of VCAA requirements and new French Study, including oral examination requirements -general conversation and cultural product
- strong collaborative and communication skills

Desirable

- prior experience in teaching/assisting teaching/tutoring to secondary school students, in particular VCE students
- knowledge of digital language resources
- University degree or other, preferably relating to Humanities or Linguistics
